Security of Your Personal Information

- When we collect and process personal information, and while we retain this information, we will protect it within commercially acceptable means to prevent loss and theft, as well as unauthorised access, disclosure, copying, use or modication.

How Long We Keep Your Personal Information

If your personal information is no longer required for this purpose, we will delete it or make it anonymous by removing all details that identify you. - Notification of data breaches: We will comply with laws applicable to us in respect of any data breach.
- Complaints: If you believe that we have breached a relevant data protection law and wish to
